



Japanese Export log prices took a dip along with China prices the first of March. This is partly due to an oversupply as everybody jumped on the high log prices and simply delivered too many logs too fast. It may take a month or two to flush out the log yards before exporters return to a strong appetite for logs from small landowners.

Domestic log prices are still very good and will continue to hold up the China market. There will be no problem selling any logs, we will just need to be watchful on our marketing strategies.

Planting season is in full swing. If you have a need for seedlings, we will soon know how many trees we have surplus and will be able to sell to some.
